Position of Leadership Duties and Requirements

Patrol Leader

These items must be accomplished to the best of the scout's ability, or completed to the satisfaction of the troop's Scoutmasters in order to receive credit for this troop level position of responsibility. The scout will be expected to complete a "Self Assessment" form and present it at the Scoutmaster Conference upon the conclusion of this position's term.

Term: 12 Months

During his term of office, the Patrol Leader must:

- Serves as the primary leader of his patrol
- Attend at least 2/3's of the troop meetings
- Participate in the preparation and facilitation of troop meetings
- Perform Calling Tree responsibilities weekly, or as required
- Represent his patrol at the monthly PLC meeting (*finds a replacement and notifies the SPL if he is unable to attend*)
- Attend at least 2/3's of monthly PLC meetings
- Attend at least 2/3's of monthly outings
- Ensure that his Assistant Patrol Leader acts in his place when he is unable to attend
- Maintain advancement status of all patrol members
- Act as mentor to all patrol members, guiding them in advancement and learning scouting skills
- Participate in the preparation and facilitation of monthly outings
- Attend Courts of Honor
- Assign duties and responsibilities to members of his patrol as required
- Assists his Patrol Quartermaster, and Patrol Scribe to ensure that their roles are being fulfilled
- Participate in the Annual Planning Conference
- Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law
- Show Scout spirit

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- Lead by setting a good example for other Scouts
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Senior Patrol Leader
- Be certified by the Scoutmaster that you have adequately completed the duties and requirements of this position.

Qualifications for the position of Patrol Leader are:

- Age 12 minimum
- Must be 1st Class Rank or higher
- Must have been a member of Troop 147 for a minimum of 6 months
- Must have successfully completed Troop Leadership Training

Statement of Commitment:

Having been elected to the position of Patrol Leader, I hereby promise to cheerfully perform all the duties of my office as stated above and commit to the above participation requirements. I understand that failure to honor this commitment during my term of office may result in the loss of my leadership position and/or the loss of leadership credit toward my rank advancement.
